Tad” is a priest of the diocese of Fall River, Massachusetts and Director of Education for The National Catholic Bioethics Center in Philadelphia. He is an internationally known expert on bioethical issues.

March 5 “End of Life Issues”

Presented by a panel of moral, legal, & medical professionals which will include **Dr. Peter J. Colosi**, a professor of philosophy and moral theology at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary. Dr. Colosi expresses the moral teachings of the Catholic Church in ways that get at the underlying reasons behind those teachings.
