* ***“First Corinthians: The Church And The Christian Community”***

This **11-session** study is led by Fr. Michael Fitzpatrick and presented on DVD by Dr. Tim Gray. The conflicts of the early Christians in Corinth with divisions, immorality, persecution, and other trials are in many ways similar to our struggles today. The message of St. Paul to the Corinthians is a much needed message for our own times. This study explores the key elements that the apostle Paul introduced about the nature of grace, the Church as the Body of Christ, the gift of the Eucharist, and how to live a Christian life in the midst of a pagan culture. You will receive a binder workbook, readings for home study and discussion in class, as well as view a 30 minute DVD.

* ***“A Quick Journey Through The Bible”***

This **8-session** study is designed to give the student a brief overview of salvation history, from Genesis through the resurrection of Christ and the establishment of the Catholic Church, giving participants the *‘big picture’* of the Bible. The complexity of the Bible is made simple through an easy-to-follow narrative approach and the ingenious color-coded *Bible Timeline System*. Participants view a 30 minute DVD presentation by Jeff Cavins and engage in group discussion using *A Bible Timeline Chart*, Study Guide, *Bible Timeline Bookmark*, and a Memory Bead Wristband.
